



CODE OF CONDUCT

- A valid reservation is required for entry. Guests may only sit in their reserved lounge chairs, daybeds, or cabanas and must show their proof of reservation when requested.
- Children over 2 years of age require a reservation. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- Guests under 21 years of age are not permitted in designated 21+ areas. All parties in a reservation for 21+ areas must show valid ID upon entry. Guests with a reservation for 21+ areas who do not meet these requirements may be denied entry.
- No outside food or drink items are allowed in Cascades, although exceptions will be made for those with medical and/or special needs.
- No smoking or vaping is allowed within Cascades. Smoking or vaping is permitted only in designated areas outside the venue.
- Appropriate swim wear is required when swimming. No cut-offs or jean shorts are allowed in the water.
- Excess lotions, oils, or residue must be removed from skin before entering the water.
- No floats or toys of any kind are allowed in the water.
- Diving, running, and/or rough play are prohibited within Cascades.
- Persons with open wounds, bandages, or any symptom of communicable disease may not enter the water.
- Maximum pool depth: 4'0"
